

Thursday No Tap Mixed League
2011 League Bylaws

1. League practice will begin Thursdays at 7:00 P. M., league play will begin at 7:08 P.M...
2. The league will bowl a 12 week season, with 6 weeks in the first half and 6 weeks in the second half. Wins and losses will start over after the 6th week. Average will carry through.
3. Handicap will be 80% based on the team difference method. Handicap will be figured after the first 3 games are bowled.
4. Your average will be figured after your first three games are bowled. Averages from other leagues are not valid on this league.
5. The absentee score will be 10 pins less a bowlers established average. The vacancy score will be 150 for both men and women.
6. The four point system will be used with one point awarded for each win, and one point for total pins.
7. Two bowlers constitute a legal lineup, maximum of 4 players are allowed on your teams roster. Substitutes will be allowed on position nights and in any playoffs provided that they have a minimum of 9 games bowled. Substitutes who bowl for one team only on the league will be listed with that teams lineup on league reports.
8. Tardy bowlers will be allowed to make up their frames provided the 4th frame has not been completed by the opposing team.
9. In the case of a forfeit the team present must bowl within 90 percent of their team average. No handicap will be given; the team not present will lose all 4 points.
10. This league is certified by USBC and all rules of that governing organization will be followed. Bowlers will be eligible for appropriate USBC awards which they may earn. Men's certification costs \$15.00, Women's certification costs \$16.00. If you have a valid 2010/2011 card you do not have to pay for certification, but you must still fill out an application.
11. The cost of bowling will be \$15.00 per week which includes bowling, prize money, and secretaries and treasurers salaries.
12. Team captains will bring their league money and envelope to the front desk and sign for the amount paid by the end of the first game.
13. Prebowling will be allowed, you can prebowl up to a maximum of 3 times each half. Postbowling is not allowed at any time. Prebowed games will count toward a legal lineup.
14. All playoffs will be determined by total pins. End of season playoffs **should** be held on the 2 Thursdays immediately following the last week of regular league play. Teams unable to bowl during this time may bowl at a time agreeable to both teams involved, and lane availability.
15. You must have at least 2/3 of all games bowled to be eligible for an individual award or trophy. Individual awards include: high average, high game, high series, and most improved bowler, only one individual award will be given per bowler, the highest award that you are eligible for.
16. All bowlers (both regular bowlers and substitutes) must have at least 9 games bowled on our league to be eligible to bowl in any playoffs.
17. A bus trip/clambake survey will be taken during the 3rd week of bowling, from the 3rd to the 6th week of bowling, guest money will be collected. Final arrangements, including all guest money being paid in full, must be by the 6th week of bowling. After the 6th week we will not be able to process any requests for refunds. Due to limited seating bus trip guests are on a first paid, first guaranteed basis. Any bowlers wishing to do both events on a space available basis. The league will pay for one event, the bowler must pay for the other.
18. You must have all 12 weeks dues paid in to be eligible to go on the bus trip or to the clambake. Bowlers joining after the first week will be responsible to pay \$3.90 per week for any weeks missed if they want to do the end of season events.
19. A trophy committee and a 50/50 coordinator will be named by the league. Volunteers are welcome.
20. All rules not covered here will be covered by official USBC rules.
